



We represent the only survivor of the Kingsmills massacre.

Mr Alan Black wants to challenge the coroner on his oversight of issues of intelligence in the Kingsmills inquest.

He has a particular concern about the ongoing failure to learn of the identity of 2 PIRA suspects allegedly involved in the killings of his work colleagues.

Speaking today on announcement of the legal action solicitor Kevin Winters said, "We recognize these are sensitive and complex issues the Coroner has to navigate around. The decision to take legal action isn't taken lightly but really it comes on the back of a number of developments including a recent BBC Spotlight documentary implicating one man in the killings. Mr Black has heightened suspicions around what happened in 1976 especially in relation to alleged State collusion. This has been a difficult decision for him but he feels he has no option given what he feels is mounting rather than diminishing suspicions on what happened. He is 77 now and he just feels he has little option to get to the truth."
