This panel is aimed at addressing the historical injustices faced by countless individuals.

It is an opportunity for victims to have their voices heard, their stories acknowledged, and their pain validated. By coming forward, victims can also contribute to a collective effort to ensure that such atrocities are never repeated.

We understand that the decision to come forward can be daunting. Many victims have carried the weight of their experiences in silence for years, and the prospect of revisiting those memories may be overwhelming. However, it is important to remember that you are not alone. KRW Law has years of experience representing historical abuse victims within the traditional legal setting and at Inquiries and can support victims throughout their engagement with the Panel.
